
The predominant use of wool in our carpets ensures that we have a sustainable supply of this rapidly renewable material.


PERFORMANCE

AXFELT


Made from 100% recycled materials, Axfelt Triple Layer Underlay is the sustainable choice for residential projects. Instead of ending up in landfill, we divert waste materials – including our waste wool and carpet - to our factory in Devon where it is transformed into luxury underlay.

SOLIDWOOL

Chairs made of wool! As a new way of working with wool, Solidwool is a unique, composite material with wool as the reinforcement and bio-resin as the binder. Made using wool from upland, hill-farmed sheep that is now considered almost worthless, the Hembury Chair is finished with sustainably-sourced, hand-turned Ash legs.
